An In-Person Tour and Exploration of the Nassau County Museum of Art's New Exhibit *La Belle Epoque*

**Thursday May 13, 2021
4:00 PM to 6:30 PM**

The new exhibit captures Paris' age of elegance between 1880 and the eve of World War I in 1914. Celebrated for its hallmark joie de vivre, the Belle Epoque became hailed as a Golden Age between the hardships of the Third Republic and the trauma of World War I. Participants will embark on an active exploration of the Museum's galleries including an exquisite collection of Louis Comfort Tiffany lamps and paintings and prints by artists including Henri Martin, Edgar Degas and Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec.

We will investigate the influences of leisure, industry, science and art on the lives of Parisian residents in the late 19th & early 20th centuries. Weather permitting, we will walk the grounds especially the Museum's Sculpture Garden.

This event is art centered; inquiry based and designed to engage viewers in participatory experiences and to address the NYS Learning and Common Core Standards for the Arts.
