**Addressing the Needs of our Challenging Students  
Why Our Kids with Behavioral Challenges Are Falling  
Through the Cracks and How We Can Help**

Ross W. Greene, Ph.D. is the originator of the innovative, research-based model of intervention now known as Collaborative & Proactive Solutions (CPS) as described in his influential books *The Explosive Child*, *Lost at School*, *Lost & Found*, and *Raising Human Beings*. He is also the developer and executive producer of the documentary film, *The Kids We Lose*. Dr. Greene served on the faculty of the Harvard Medical School for over 20 years, and is now Founding Director of the non-profit *Lives in the Balance* ([www.livesinthebalance.org](http://www.livesinthebalance.org)), which aims to disseminate the CPS model through no-cost web-based programming; advocate on behalf of behaviorally challenging kids and their parents and teachers; and encourage the use of non-punitive, non-adversarial interventions.

This full day conference will focus on strategies that teachers can use in the classroom to identify and assess the various skills that are central to handling life's social, emotional and behavioral challenges. Dr. Greene's model focuses on solving problems rather than on modifying behavior using collaborative solutions.
