### Restorative Practices for Positive Classroom Learning Dominique Smith



Dominique Smith is the chief of Educational Services and Teacher Relations at Health Sciences and Middle College in San Diego, California. He has helped transform the College to become a restorative school with his efforts in building relationships with students. His focus on school wide mind shifts to restorative practices and school equity have taken him across the country to help schools make change. Dominique focuses on creating a well-rounded school climate to allow the growth of all students to become the best student they can be.

This session – Restorative Practices for Positive Classroom Learning- will focus on a practical blueprint for creating a cooperative and respectful classroom climate in which students and teachers work through behavioral issues together. Studies show that when educators empower students to address and correct misbehavior among themselves, positive results are longer lasting and wide reaching. Topics will include establishing procedures and expectations for student behavior that will encourage the development of positive interpersonal skills and implementing conflict resolution strategies that prioritize relationship building and mutual understanding.

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
